

CPR & First Aid

Are you a foster parent and need to fulfill the new CPR and First Aid Certification requirements? This is the perfect opportunity! IFAPA's CPR and First Aid class is designed to give you the confidence to respond in an emergency situation with skills that can save a life. IFAPA's CPR & First Aid training classes are presented by CPR and First Aid certified trainers and have been approved by DHS as an approved training for foster parents.

NEW DHS RULE - All foster parents shall be certified in child CPR and First Aid every three years through a nationally recognized training organization or by an equivalent certified trainer. Foster parents shall maintain a certificate indicating the date of training and expiration. Current foster homes who are licensed by October 1, 2009 must complete the training by October 1, 2010. All foster parents shall complete training in CPR and first aid in their first year of licensure. Internet training classes will NOT meet this training requirement.
