

## **Understanding and Responding to the Sexual Behaviors of Children and Adolescents**

This training, based on curriculum developed by the Kempe Center for Prevention & Treatment of Child Abuse and Neglect in Denver, CO, will give parents the tools they need to understand what sexual behaviors are normal at various ages and developmental stages and what behaviors might be considered abusive or problematic. The trainer will share strategies parents can implement when speaking with children or youth in response to their sexual behavior and participants will have the opportunity to practice responding to various real-life situations they might encounter involving the sexual behavior of children and adolescents.
